The ABCs of the Israeli-Palestinian Conflict [In Jerusalem or along Road 6 in the Sharon Region or the Gaza Envelope]

Terms like "West Bank," "Settlements," "The Anti-Terror Fence," "The Green Line," "Defensible Borders," and "Israel's Narrow Waist" are more tangible because you see them on the ground. Like many other countries like Sudan, Turkey, and Saudi Arabia, Israel has built a protective fence. We will discuss why the Fence was built and its impact, and I will share behind-the-scenes stories regarding the way Israel confronts the challenge of terrorism and suicide bombers.

When it seems like the Old City, East and West Jerusalem are in the palm of your hand. When in one glance, you can see the Anti-Terror Fence, Bethlehem, Ramallah, Tel Aviv, and the Dead Sea, you begin to build a holistic and comprehensive picture of the region and can better grapple with the real issues in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. We will also spend time delving into definitions and terms like Israeli-Arab, Palestinian, Jerusalemite Palestinian, Citizen, Permanent Resident, etc. After this tour, we will also understand how everything in the Middle East is connected, and nothing stands alone.... especially when it comes to Jerusalem!

Golan Heights [Syrian Border]

The war in Syria is one of the most significant events in the history of the Middle East. The war puts the future of the Golan Heights and the entire Middle East into question. <u>Standing on the Syrian border</u>, a mere twenty miles from Damascus, we will explore the war in Syria, discuss the potential for the "*Sinaization*" of the Golan, understand the sources and impact of Assad's allegiances and alliances from Russia to Turkey to Iran, how the war impacts the region and Israel's current and future security posture, and what the future holds.

Israel's Northern Front | The Iranian Shi'ite Crescent & Corridor [Lebanese and / or Syrian Border]

Iran wants to be the regional superpower. The backbone of Tehran's hegemonic strategy is a network of armed agents and proxies. For the last decade, Iran has been building an Iranian-controlled corridor from Iran through Iraq, Syria, and Lebanon to the Mediterranean Sea. This land bridge is the most significant military threat Israel is facing. Therefore, Israel has vowed it will do whatever it takes to prevent Iran from securing the corridor. What is the crescent? What is the corridor? How has Iran built this infrastructure? What threat does it hold for Israel and the region? What must be done to ensure the Crescent and Corridor do not materialize? What are the risks if it does?

The Lebanese Border

The view from Israel into Lebanon is breathtaking. However, external forces and inner struggles have wrenched this county for generations. <u>Standing on the Lebanese border</u>, we will delve into Lebanon's history, why the complex fabric of Lebanon and Lebanese society makes it fertile ground for continuing violence and chaos, explore the major forces that play a role in this struggling country, and understand the impact of the primary players - including Hezbollah, Iran, and Syria on southern Lebanon and Israel. We will discuss the current atmosphere in the country, the impact on Israel's geostrategic posture, the future of Lebanon, and the ramifications on the region.



Two People, One Land, Many Narratives – Tour of The West Bank / Judea & Samaria
