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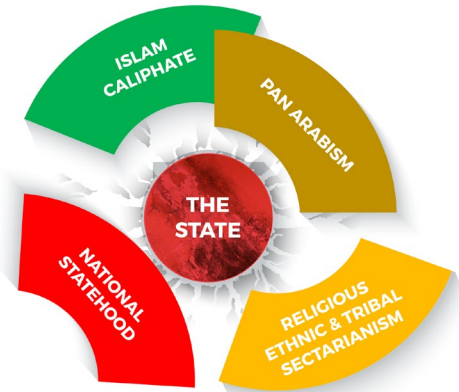

- ❖ “Arab Spring” – **BURST OF ANGER & FRUSTRATION** across the Arab world

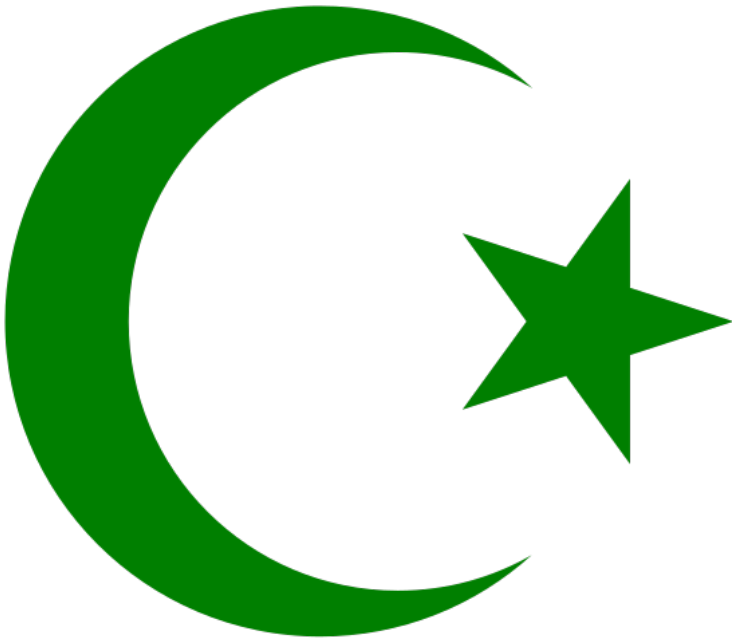

INTRODUCTION

ISLAM



Islam – the full submission of the individual to the rule of one god – **Allah** ('The God')

Sariah is the Islamic law codex that guide the believer in every aspect of life.

Islam does not separate between religion and state.

In Islamic view – **the two are intertwined.**



19TH CENTURY



Muhammad Abduh
(1849–1905)



Jamal Uddin al-Afghan
(1838–1897)

Islamist modernists believed creating a society governed by the ideals and laws of pure **early Islamic *sharī ah***, which also **embraced modernity**, was the **cure for the challenges of Muslim society**.

Though opposed to the West and its values, the modernists **did not** regard the Muslim society's **encounter with the West** and its culture to only be **a source of threat**; instead, they viewed the meeting of the two as an opportunity for cultural, economic, political, and social growth—**progress for Arab societies and for the world of Islam**.



POLITICAL ISLAM & ITS LARGEST MOVEMENT- THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD



Hassan al-Bana (1906 – 1949)

Islam is **Under Attack**

Establish a **Caliphate** completely governed by **Shari'ah** in which no other independent or sovereign state exists.

Completely **rejects political frameworks, ideologies, philosophies, and values that are not Islamic** (communism, democracy, socialism, etc.) because they are man-made and, therefore, imperfect, unjust, & doomed to fail. **Acceptance of anything aside from Shari'ah defies Allah.**

Completely **oppose** and are in direct **conflict** with **Western values**, which are an **imminent and existential threat to Islam.**

Violent Secret Branch

Umma VS. **Statehood**

Uncompromising opposition to the existence of the **State of Israel**

Create support and cultivate power base through **Da'wah - education and preaching and creating economic, educational, social, and welfare programs and creating educational and religious programs and institutions.**

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| POLITICAL ISLAM & THE MUSLIM BROTHERHOOD



SALAFI IDEOLOGY



The word *salaf* means the past of something, **its origin / its roots / its primal source.**

Islam will thrive and flourish again once Islam adopts and applies the **Islamic codes, law, norms and values as they were in the time of the Prophet Muhammad and his first four successors.**

The **combination** of deepening multi-faceted **crises in the Arab world**, together with the **oppression of the Muslim Brotherhood**, resulted in an almost inevitable **ideological radicalization** that then evolved into a process of **militarization** within Islamic circles.

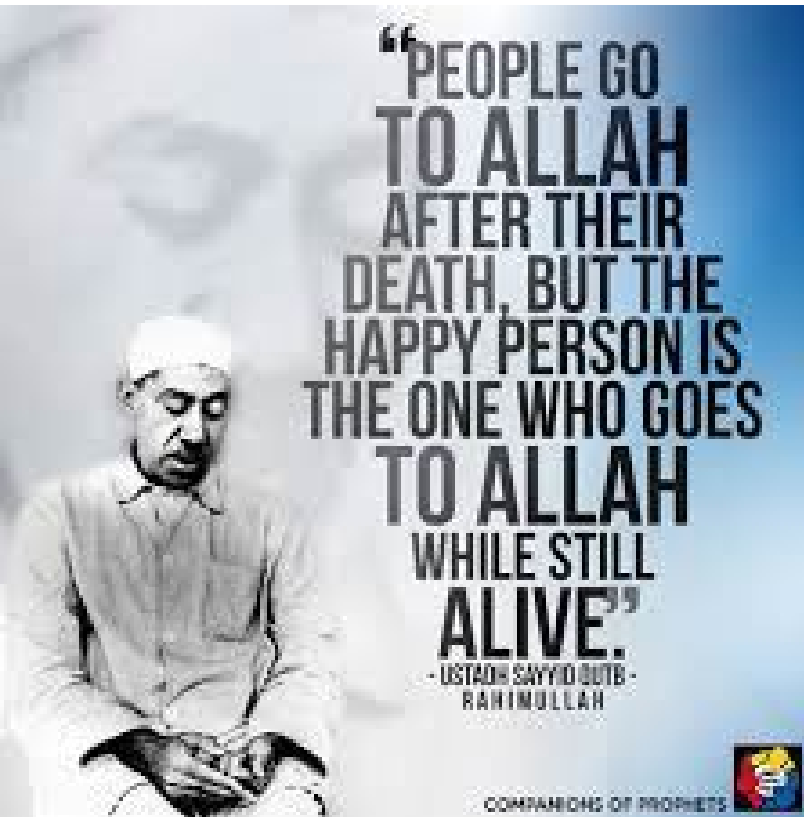
The leading advancer of the **radical and violent militarization of Islam** was a senior member of the Muslim Brotherhood. A man named **Sayyid Qutb.**

SAYYID QUTB | LAID THE FOUNDATION FOR SALAFI-JIHADI MILITANT ISLAM



Sayyid Qutb 1906 - 1966

- '*Jahiliya*'
- Full obedience to *Allah's* law and rule
- Total rejection of Western values
- Fighting 'fake' Muslim rulers and regimes
- Total rejection of Democracy
- Strict Implementation of *Shari'ah* law
- Non-compromising animosity towards infidels
- Anti-Jews and Anti-Israel
- Establishing the Caliphate

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| SAYYID QUTB & SALAFI JIHADI MILITANT ISLAM



SALAFI JIHADI MILITANT ISLAM | CORE VALUES & PRINCIPLES



- *'Jihad'*
- Establishing the *Caliphate*
- Strict Implementing of *Shari'ah* law
- Request of Martyrdom (*'Talab al-Shahadah'*)
- The West, Shi'ites, infidels and Jews are eternal enemies
- *Takfir* - Ousting "fake" Muslim rulers & regimes

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| SALAFI-JIHADI MILITANT ISLAM IDEOLOGY



RADICALIZATION OF SALAFI-JIHADI MILITANT ISLAM | TAKFIR

TAKFIR ideology: Three kinds of people: **Muslims**, **Infidels** (*kuffar*), and **Muslims** who “pretend” to be Muslims but are not “real Muslims,” they are “**fake Muslims.**” Fake Muslims are **WORSE** than *kuffar* because they are corrupting” and “contaminating” Islam and its values from within. Therefore, **Islam** must be “**purified**” of “**Muslim impersonators.**” Examples of Militant Islam groups that follow the **Takfir** are **Al-Qaeda** & **ISIS**.



ISIS says there are **TWO KINDS** of **fake Muslims**. Muslims who **knowingly and intentionally do not follow the Shari'ah, and worse – they pretend they do.** In ISIS' view they are destined to die and **must be executed** because they are **contaminating Islam from within**. Muslims who **out of ignorance do not follow the Shari'ah**. They, **should be redirected to see the light – meaning Islam – through education – and if needed, through the use of non-fatal punishments and sanctions – to become “true” Muslims.**

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| **RADICALIZATION PROCESS**





Militant Islam that appeared in the 20th century is the product of three main factors:

- **Fundamentalist thinking** which existed in Islam throughout history.
- The **direct encounter with the West** that revealed the **inferiority of the Islamic world in relationship to the West.**
- The **Socio-political-economic hardships in the Muslim and Arab world; Corrupt & oppressive regimes & rulers; Environment engulfed with violence and aggression.**
