
1916 | THE SYKES - PICOT AGREEMENT

THE VISION OF THE 'ARAB KINGDOM OF SYRIA' UNDER THE HASHEMITE DYNASTY RULE



GREAT BRITIAN ESTABLISHES THE EMIRATE OF TRANS JORDAN



JORDAN | CONTEMPORARY MILESTONES

- April 1921 Establishment of the Hashemite Emirate of Trans Jordan (British protectorate), Amir Abdullah Bin al-Hussein (1882-1951)
- May 1946 TJ independence. TJ becomes "The Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan" King Abdullah Bin al-Hussein (1882-1951)
- **1948 1967** Jordan occupied and annexed the West Bank
 - July 1951 King Abdullah was assassinated at the Al-Aqsa Mosque, Jerusalem
- 1951- 1952 King Talal Bin Abdullah
- **1952 1999** King Hussein Bin Talal (Born 1935)
 - 1967 The Six Day War Israel occupies the West Bank
 - 1970 "Black September" military collision between the Jordanian Monarchy and Palestinian armed militias in Jordan
 - 1988 Jordan detached its administrative connection to the West Bank (except for Jerusalem)
 - **1994** Jordan and Israel sign Peace Treaty
- 1999 Now King Abdullah II Bin Hussein
